RPP covers...	
Damage to United Rentals Equipment	Accidental damage, as long as the damage does not result from intentional abuse of the equipment.
Damage to United Rentals Vehicles	Damage to United Rentals vehicles, provided the customer or permissive user of a customer does not use the vehicle in violation of any terms of the Rental Agreement or of any law. Note: RPP Opt Out is not necessary for motor vehicle rentals.
Theft of United Rentals Equipment and Vehicles	Theft of equipment and vehicles.
RPP does not cover...	
Damage to Tires	Damage to tires and tubes caused by blow out, bruises, cuts, punctures or other causes inherent in the use of the equipment.
Damage to Equipment Resulting From Abuse	Damage to equipment resulting from intentional abuse.

*\*\*Customer is responsible for the care and safekeeping of the rental equipment from the time of delivery until retrieval by the Company. Customer agrees that it will use its best efforts to protect the equipment from loss, theft or damage at all times during the rental period, and until the equipment is retrieved and in the Company's possession.*
